Here are a few things to expect on for day 4 as well as what to do next after the class. Please keep this sheet for easy reference.

TESTING INFO

-day 4 all students will be taking a final exam in order to pass the drivers ed class. They must score 80 percent or above

-The final exam is NOT the permit/dmv/state exam. That is separate and in NO way can be substituted in its place. The permit test can be taken one of 3 ways.

First option: it is available online at home via dmv. Go to this website: [@Home Driving Knowledge Tests | Department of Revenue - Motor Vehicle \(colorado.gov\)](#)

Second option: physically do the dmv at take the permit test there via dmv appointment

Third option: we test weekly (sometimes biweekly) in person at our office. The times/dates are under announcements on our website. Fee is \$30 per test. These tests are given as a group and not scheduled individually.

Certificate information

- All certificates will arrive in your spam email of the email you listed on the dmv site when you applied for the code/customer identification number. It arrives under the heading "DMV EXAM COMPLETION Statement" Again, this is NOT the permit test. It is a drivers education certificate. Please do not think this replaces the permit test in any manner.
- It is strongly advised you save this document for years to come so that if you want insurance discounts you won't need to pay additional fees for us to search dmv data for you to attain it again.
- Please be sure you pull your student's certificate tomorrow even if they are not going dmv for several weeks of months. Spam deletes itself. If you wait until the day you are visiting the dmv and have not yet pulled your paperwork, this will delay things if we are tied up with driving or road tests.

WHAT DO I TAKE TO DMV

- Drivers ed cert
- Social security card
- Birth cert
- 2 proofs of address of parent
- You will be required to arrive at the DMV by appointment only. Here is the link to schedule that [Online Scheduler \(cxmflow.com\)](#)

If you signed up for driving after this class please know the contract is valid for 18 months or one year....whichever comes first. The year is based on the permit issue date. Please don't wait for the "perfect" opportunity schedule wise to begin booking. Weather, car issues, student and instructor illness can delay your ability to book. Two weeks of practice is required in between drives, so waiting

until the last minute will result in your student exceeding the contract agreement and you may face additional fees if you choose to drive past those dates.

- All booking is done on the student portal. Please re read your contract for the driving so you are familiar with late cancellations, showing up without permit, etc. This is located on our homepage and it is also in your file in your student portal along with all emails sent to you thus far and in the future.
